REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 5, 2014 – 5:45PM

Mayor Campolong called meeting to order.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters was made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter into Executive Session were discussed during the Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. Dickerson; pledge immediately followed.

Motion to accept minutes as written from the Regular Town Council Meeting of June 24, 2014 made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Council is invited to attend. The Police Department will have a booth on August 12. The radars were purchased and installed in both police cars.

Reports by Council

Councilman McLeod stated that the power lines are down for the lighting for the walk trail. Construction has begun on the concession stand. If anyone has any suggestions for the betterment of the Recreation Department, new ideas are welcomed.

Councilman Green stated that more sidewalks were added coming from McBee High on E. Juniper to Hwy 1; the sidewalk was replaced in front of Skip Mayes' Rambler.
