Reports:

Recreation Director: Shilon Green

Family Day was held on May 14, 2016 with approximately 200 in attendance. This was our first “Family Day” and we are pleased with how well it turned out. I would like to thank Councilman McLeod for the strawberries he brought to the event. Everyone really enjoyed them.

This will be an annual event and I would like to request that the Council consider naming the event the “Jonathan Drew Memorial Day” in memory of Jonathan who died in an accident this year.

Water Leak Adjustment Request

One of our commercial water customers had a water leak this past month that created a water usage of over 250,000 gallons of water, which created a billing in the amount of \$1,093.68. The customer has requested a leak adjustment and has submitted the forms for the request. The water line has been repaired. The adjustment would be in the amount of \$749.25. The balance has been calculated as an average of their normal monthly bill plus the wholesale rate of the excess gallons of water.

Man-hole Cover on Hwy. 151

Councilman Marion Stephens had requested that I find out who was responsible for the manhole cover located on Hwy. 151 and 6th St. It has sunk down into the street and has caused the window to crack in the building located in front of the manhole. Sandhill Telephone is the responsible party and has stated that they would get the manhole repaired.

School Safety Signals:

Councilman A.C. McLeod requested that a request be made to the County office for an engineer to meet with the Council to look at the school safety signal issue.

Mayor Campolong agreed that a copy of the letter that was mailed to the district office would be sent to the County office.

Free Mulch

As a courtesy, the town has been offering delivery of free mulch to residents over the past couple of years as it became available. This has become a time-consuming issue and I would like to request that this be reviewed for other options.

Mayor Campolong agreed that this is not something the Town is required to offer and that the maintenance department stop delivering mulch effective immediately and the Council will look at what other Towns are offering and what McBee could offer in the future.

Historical Items

Chesterfield County Administration has built a new building and would like to receive any historical items from the Towns in order to put on display in their new offices.

Mayor Campolong agreed that we would see if there were any items the Town could send.

Councilman A. C. McLeod

Family Day went really well and we have completed everything at the Recreation Complex that we have been working on. We should be able to close up the grant and get reimbursed for the remainder of the expenses. We have a good facility and in a good place between the two schools and easy access to the families.
