REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 1, 2011 – 5:55 PM

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was present and typed minutes.

Mayor Campolong called meeting to order.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, and legal matters for contractual matters made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Invocation made by Rev. McCluney and pledge immediately followed.

Motion to accept minutes as written from Regular Town Council Meeting on February 1, 2011 made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Melinda Brown, concerned citizen, questioned matters regarding the Recreation Department.

Councilwoman Fields stated that she would see what the price would be for 33 flags.

Councilman Green stated that Council need to discuss some items in the drafted dog ordinance.

Sim Tyner, town maintenance, gave a report for the maintenance department. He stated that he picked up some extra garbage cans from customers that weren't being paid for. He gave prices for LED bulbs for the Christmas lights. He gave information on the drop boxes and weather heads for poles in which the Christmas lights are hung. He stated that the septic tank was pumped and the drain lines are possibly clogged.

Mayor Campolong stated that even with the simultaneous reading of the master meter and the town customer reading that there is a discrepancy of 400,000 gallons.

Chief Hayes stated that the police clerk computer had crashed. Lawtrak recommends that it is run on a computer by itself. He asked Council for a server for Police Department. He stated that a McBee owns a repeater. The repeater is on top of the water tower. He stated that the transmission line and antenna are from the 1970's; they need to be replaced. He told Council

that the new police car needed tires. He stated that police department had 21 written incidents, 91 traffic summons, and 2 narcotic cases. He also stated that there has been an increase in public drunkenness.

Motion to buy a server for Police Department made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to give authority to Councilman Sutton to look at tires on new police car and to bind tires, if necessary, made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong will talk to Sheriff Parker about the hardware for the repeater.

Motion to adjourn made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.
