REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 4, 2011 – 6:10 PM

Mayor Campolong called meeting to order.

Invocation was made by Rev. Wesley Webb and pledge immediately followed.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, and legal matters for contractual matters made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong opened the Public Hearing. There was no discussion.

Motion to close Public Hearing made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to accept second reading of Ordinance 2011-4 franchise fees for Progress Energy made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Council Reports:

Councilwoman Fields stated that the corn maize was open. She announced that the Christmas Parade will be on December 3 at 4:30 PM.

Motion to accept minutes as written from Regular Town Council Meeting on September 6, 2011 made by Councilman Green; seconded by Mayor Campolong. All were in favor.

Councilman McLeod gave an update about the corn maize. He stated that \$2980 has been donated to the recreation park from the corn maize, so far. He stated that he wanted to name the recreation park, "Field of Dreams." He also stated that the Fall Festival is October 29. McLeod Farms is raffling 2 tickets to the Carolina/Clemson game.

Councilman Green stated that letters to homeowners of dilapidated house are being sent out. He is receiving good feedback from homeowners. He stated the cemetery looks better. Councilman McLeod donated the material to spray the weeds but needs an applicator.

Mayor Campolong stated that the audit was mostly completed and a work session will be soon.
