REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 6, 2013 – 5:45PM

Present: John Campolong Jr., Martin Driggers Jr. (Town Attorney), Marilyn Fields, Shilon Green, Terri King (Administrator), A. C. McLeod Jr., & Charlie Sutton

Note to Minutes: Latondra Johnson, Interim Town Clerk, was absent and typed minutes.

Mayor Campolong called meeting to order.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Motion to verify that only the items stated in the motion to enter Executive Session were discussed during Executive Session made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Councilman McLeod left early.

Invocation made by Councilwoman Fields; pledge immediately followed.

Motion to accept reading for Regular Town Council Meeting on July 2, 2013 as written made by Councilwoman Fields; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Mrs. King announced the annual audit will begin the week of August 12. She stated that the maintenance men have new uniforms. She spoke of the bids for the trail grant and pre-evaluation for the walk trail.

Motion to accept bid from Furr Grading & Paving for walk trail made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Sutton. All were in favor.

Mrs. King stated that a JAG grant has been awarded to the Police Department for technology; it is unknown when it will be allotted. She announced that a truck was purchased for the Maintenance Department.

Mayor Campolong stated that the Tiller's are requesting for an abandonment of alleyway 80. Town Attorney Martin stated this is a 20 foot alleyway bordered west by Second Street, east by Third Street, South by Cypress Street, and north by Juniper Street.

Motion to accept of first reading of Ordinance 2013-2 "Ordinance to Abandon Block 80 Alleyway" made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman Green. All were in favor.

Mrs. King stated that it is the goal of the Maintenance Department to have the sidewalks clear before school starts.

Mayor Campolong stated that some more sidewalks will be added and repaired.

Councilwoman Fields stated the committee will be meeting soon for the Christmas Parade.

Mayor Campolong stated the Town Hall will be closed September 2.

Motion to adjourn made by Councilman Green; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.
