REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

Mayor Campolong welcomed the public.

Councilman McLeod presented a plaque to Jamie Wayne for 25 years of service as Director of the McBee Recreation Department.

Halloween Trick or Treat Hours will be on October 31 between 6-8 PM for children 12 and under.

The concession stand for the Recreation Complex is 99% complete. AO Smith donated \$13,000 towards the park. The next project is planting grass and the parking lot.

Mayor Campolong called meeting to order.

Invocation made by Councilwoman Fields; pledge immediately followed.

Motion to approve minutes from September 9, 2014 as written made by Councilman McLeod; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong stated that the Supreme Court ruled that an invocation could be held at public meetings with certain stipulations. The town will be in compliance with the US Constitution with Resolution 2014-4 “A Resolution to Select Invocation Speakers for Town Council Meetings.”

Motion to accept Resolution 2014-4 made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.

Mayor Campolong spoke on Resolution 2014-5 “A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of McBee Concerning the Creation of a Countywide Joint Authority Sewer System.”

Motion to accept Resolution 2014-5 made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilwoman Fields. All were in favor.

Mrs. King reported that the lights for walking trail are completed. The representative of the state grant will inspect the walking trail; the town will be reimbursed \$95,931.73. McBee will host Quarterly Mayor’s Meeting on October 23 at 7:00 PM. On October 29, Congressman Tom Rice Mobile Office will be at Town Hall between 10:00 AM-12:00 PM. The Annual Christmas

Parade is on December 6 at 4:30 PM. Senior Dinner will be on December 9, and the Angel Tree Dinner will be on December 16. We are still having problems with people driving and cutting donuts on the running track. Council took the issue under advisement.

Motion to enter into Executive Session pursuant to SC Code FOIA 30-4-70 (a) (1) (2) to discuss employee matters, legal matters for contractual matters was made by Mayor Campolong; seconded by Councilman McLeod. All were in favor.
